This License Agreement is applicable to the ErgVideo Player software and all of the ErgVideo multimedia content (video and data files contained and produced). You are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the terms of this License Agreement when you purchase or install or use the ErgVideo application and multimedia content, hereinafter referred to as the ERGVIDEO PRODUCTS.

1 Definitions

When used in this Agreement, the following terms shall have the respective meanings indicated, such meanings to be applicable to both the singular and plural forms of the terms defined:

"Software" means (a) all of the contents of the files, disk(s), CD-ROM(s) or other media with which this Agreement is provided, including but not limited to (i) ErgVideo Inc. or third party computer information or software; (ii) digital images, stock photographs, clip art, sounds or other artistic works ("Stock Files"); (iii) related explanatory written materials or files ("Documentation"); and (b) upgrades, modified versions, updates, additions, and copies of the Software, if any, licensed to you by ErgVideo Inc.(collectively, "Updates").

"Licensed Content" means the ErgVideo video files and their power-specification profiles. (Note the change: Aug 2018, distinguishes "Software" and "Licensed Content").

"Use" or **"Using"** means to access, install, download, copy or otherwise benefit from using the functionality of the Software in accordance with the Documentation.

"Licensee" means You or Your Company, unless otherwise indicated.

"Permitted Number" means one (1) unless otherwise indicated under a valid license (e.g. volume license) granted by ErgVideo Inc.

"Computer" means an electronic device that accepts information in digital or similar form and manipulates it for a specific result based on a sequence of instructions.

"Licensor" means ErgVideo Inc., located at 443 Churchill Ave N, Ottawa, Ontario, Canada, K1Z 5E1.

2. Software License

While you comply with the terms of this End User License Agreement (the "Agreement"), ErgVideo Inc. grants to you a non-exclusive license to Use the Software for the purposes described in the Documentation. Some third party materials included in the Software may be subject to other terms and conditions, which are typically found in a "Read Me" file located near such materials.

3. General Use

You may install and use a copy of the **Software** on any compatible computer. To use the software, you must provide the necessary account information. To function correctly, the software requires some identifiers to be collected, and an active account at ErgVideo.com. You agree to this collection by ErgVideo Inc.

You may install and use a copy of the **Licensed Content** on a single compatible computer. The Permitted Number is 1. This definition is strict and shall not be construed to imply any other meaning. Removal from one computer for installation to another is not implied and is not included. You may install the software and licensed content as often as necessary on the single, original computer. A limited number of exceptions to install on replacement computers may be granted upon requesting to the licensor, ErgVideo Inc.

ErgVideo Inc. shall grant separate license(s) upon additional payment(s) of the purchase price (for each one) should you wish to install and use the **Licensed Content** on other computers.

ErgVideo may be installed and licensed in a manner so that it can be used by all users of the single computer on which it is installed and licensed. However, installations on networks or network disk drives to enable use at multiple computers is prohibited.

3a Subscriptions.

You may use a subscription on a single computer only. While the **Software** can be installed on multiple computers, the functions of subscription access by the software are limited to operating on a single computer per subscription. Transfers of a subscription to replacement computers are limited by the licensor.

4. Collection of data

To automate license management and simplify it for the user, subscription management, verification of terms of use compliance, as well as to facilitate customer support, error reporting, and direct-from-ErgVideo user-customized advertising, ErgVideo may collect the data required for these purposes. Use of this data is governed by our Privacy Policy.

5. Backup Copy

You may make one backup copy of the Software and the Licensed Content, provided your backup copy is not installed or used on any computer. You may not transfer the rights to a backup copy.

6. Stock Files

The Software is protected by copyright, including without limitation by Canada's Copyright Law, international treaty provisions and applicable laws in the country in which it is being used. You may not copy the Software, except as set forth in Section 2 ("Software License").

Any copies that you are permitted to make pursuant to this Agreement must contain the same copyright and other proprietary notices that appear on or in the Software.

You also agree not to reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or otherwise attempt to discover the source code of the Software except to the extent you may be expressly permitted to decompile under applicable law.

You also agree to not tamper with or reverse engineer network access protocols or endpoints used by the software to implement the streaming services or client-server communications. Detection of tampering or investigative behavior will result in termination of all licenses.

8. Transfer

You may not rent, lease, sublicense or authorize all or any portion of the Software, Licensed content, or subscriptions to be copied onto another user's computer. Notwithstanding the foregoing, you may not transfer education, pre-release, or not for resale copies of the Software.

ErgVideo Inc. shall grant separate license(s) upon additional payment(s) of the purchase price (for each one) should you or a transferee wish to transfer, install and use the Licensed Content on other computers.

9. Termination

ErgVideo Inc reserves the right to terminate the license should non-compliance to these terms be determined, detected, or reasonably suspected.

Refusal to provide the necessary information to establish and maintain an active user-profile *account* at ErgVideo.com will also terminate all licenses to software and licensed content. Deactivating the *account* at ErgVideo.com will terminate all licenses to use the software and the licensed content immediately.

Be advised that merely cancelling a subscription is NOT the same as deactivating an account.

Subscriptions can be enabled and disabled by the user according to desired use patterns, and your *account* and licenses will remain active for non-subscribed licensed content and software, as well as to make convenient your re-subscribing for services later.
